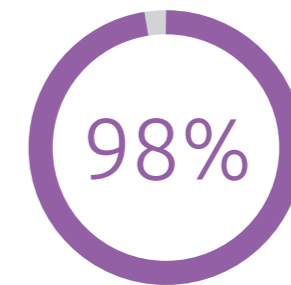
Bringing together today's brightest leaders to shape the future we all want to see.

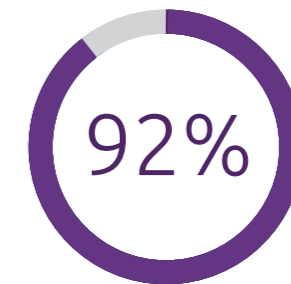

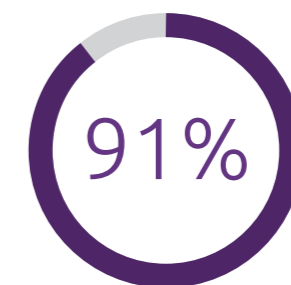

ERIN ANDREWS

Sports Broadcaster, Co-Host of Dancing with the Stars, Cancer and Adversity Survivor

One of the most recognized and respected sports broadcasters in the industry, Erin Andrews is part of FOX Sports' A Team, reporting for FOX NFL Sunday as well as reporting for NFL Thursday Night Football and co-hosting ABC's long-running reality series Dancing with the Stars.

Andrews recently added "creator" to her long list of titles with the launch of her new women's NFL apparel line, WEAR by Erin Andrews. The fashionable, comfortable and

subtle line, designed for women to wear anywhere and everywhere, has quickly garnered notable attention, becoming the #1 NFL women's only brand since it launched.

While at the top of her career with no limits in sight, Andrews was shocked when she was diagnosed with cervical cancer following a routine annual checkup. Not wanting the diagnosis to interfere with the career she had fought so hard for, Andrews quietly planned doctors' visits

around her work schedule in order to keep her diagnosis private and kept moving full speed ahead during treatment, only sharing her story publicly after she received word she was cancer free.

In empowering, insightful conversations, Andrews discusses her storied career and what it took to get to the top of her game, the challenges and triumphs of working in a male-dominated industry, and spreading awareness about cervical cancer prevention.

As the founder of Girlboss, Sophia Amoruso is the creative visionary, entrepreneur, and industry disruptor who has forged an unprecedented path in building modern brands. Named by Forbes as "Fashion's New Phenom" and featured on the cover of their "Self Made Women" issue, Amoruso has gone from one of the most prominent figures in retail to a cultural thought leader.

Amoruso is the author of New York Times 18-week bestseller #GIRLBOSS, which has sold over 500,000 copies worldwide to date. Part memoir and part business book with

an edge, #GIRLBOSS provides insights on entrepreneurship and career advice. In 2014, Amoruso launched The Girlboss Foundation, which awards financial grants to women in industries of design, fashion, music, and the arts, to help them build and grow their small businesses.

In 2015, Amoruso debuted her podcast, Girlboss Radio, which has grown to over 100,000 weekly downloads. In 2016, Amoruso released her second book Nasty Galaxy, a highly graphic and visual book that binds together the collective spirit of the

Nasty Gal brand, Amoruso's personal brand, and the Girlboss ethos.

In 2017, Netflix adapted #GIRLBOSS into a 13-episode scripted comedy series written by Kay Cannon, with Charlize Theron and Amoruso serving as Executive Producers. Today, Amoruso is working closely with a talented team at Girlboss to produce daily content across a variety of digital channels to reframe the outmoded concept model of "success" for the modern woman. Amoruso released her third publication, The Girlboss Workbook, in October of 2017.

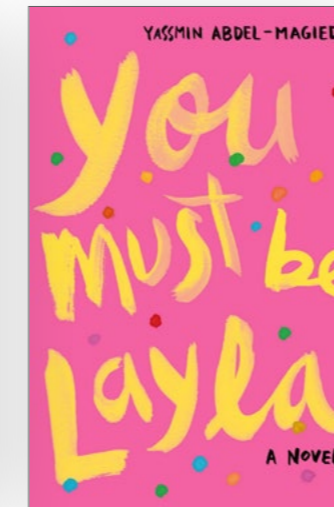
YASSMIN ABDEL-MAGIED

Yassmin Abdel-Magied is an engineer, author, broadcaster, and award-winning social advocate. Her powerful TED talk, “What does my headscarf mean to you?” has 2.2 million views, and she has become an internationally renowned speaker on unconscious bias and leadership. Through her work and thought-provoking talks, Yassmin is on a mission to make diversity the norm across the world.

At 16, Yassmin founded Youth Without Borders, an organization focused on empowering young people to positively change their communities. Driven by her love of Motorsport, she also designed a race car at

19, and graduated valedictorian with first class honours from mechanical engineering. Yassmin then went on to work as one of the few female engineers on oil and gas rigs around Australia, while continuing to advocate for social justice.

Yassmin became a lightning rod for Australia’s discussions on race, gender, and faith after an appearance on a panel show went viral, garnering 12 million views in under a week. She was presenter for the national current affairs show Australia Wide, host for the groundbreaking documentary The Truth About Racism, and co-host of the podcast Motor Mouth, on becoming a Formula 1 driver.

A bestselling author, Yassmin published her debut memoir, Yassmin’s Story at the age of 24 and her writing has appeared in publications worldwide, including The Guardian, The New York Times, and The Australian Financial Review. She is also the author of the children’s fiction book, You Must Be Layla.

Yassmin has served on numerous boards and councils, and is currently the founder of Mumtaza and an internationally sought-after advisor on issues facing women, youth, and those from racially and culturally diverse backgrounds. She has spoken in more than 20 countries across five continents.

Ritu Bhasin didn't always feel empowered to be an unapologetic, fiercely authentic leader. While she was highly successful and living the "corporate dream" in her early career, Ritu had a startling realization: the person she was in her day-to-day life bore little resemblance to her true self. Because of her experiences with racism and bullying, she found herself minimizing racial, religious, gender, and class-based aspects of her identity to "fit in" among circles where she felt she didn't belong. And in doing this, she was profoundly unhappy.

After much soul-searching, Ritu decided

to transform her life. She completed her MBA, left her corporate job, launched her own business, became a mindfulness practitioner and teacher, and dedicated her life to helping others become more empowered and inclusive. Most importantly, she committed to living as authentically as possible in all that she did going forward.

In 2010, Ritu launched bhasin consulting inc., a diversity and inclusion-focused consulting firm, and has since gained a global reputation for her work in leadership development, diversity and inclusion, and women's advancement. Through her work,

Ritu is committed to disrupting the status quo to build a world in which each of us celebrates our own differences and the differences of others. She has delivered talks to thousands, inspiring leaders to be more inclusive, and encouraging those who have experienced oppression to be more empowered. Ritu has won numerous awards for her work, including the City of Toronto's William P. Hubbard Award for Race Relations.

Ritu lives in Toronto, Canada, but travels all over the world to eat, swim, hike, dance, and work. Her first book, *The Authenticity Principle*, was released in October 2017.

Companies worldwide, including Fortune 500 companies Walmart, VISA, Johnson & Johnson, General Mills, and Royal Dutch Shell, have hired her to motivate them to achieve sustained high performance.
